

**UKRAINIAN CIVILIANS WHO, ACCORDING TO THE LAW ON ASSISTANCE TO UKRAINIAN CIVILIANS, COMPLY WITH THE SUPPORT BENEFICIARY STATUS ARE ADMITTED TO STUDY PROGRAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS LAW**

The applicant submits an application for studies **WITH** education documents attached (diploma and diploma supplement) of previous education in UA (assessed by the HEI), of previous education in LV (assessed by the HEI) or in another country (assessed by AIC\*)

University reviews the documents and checks their authenticity on the Ukrainian diploma registry

The authenticity of the diploma **is confirmed** in the registry

If their application is successful, the student can register for studies and sign the learning agreement

Confirmation of the education document assessment result is added to the student's file

There is **no confirmation** of diploma authenticity in the registry

The university submits education documents for evaluation to the AIC

AIC issues a statement that **confirms** or **does not confirm** the compliance of education indicated in the applicant's documents with Latvian educational qualifications

The costs (48,38 EUR)\*\* are covered by the state

The applicant submits an application for studies **WITHOUT** education documents attached (diploma and diploma supplement) The application is assessed by the AIC based on the delegation given in the Law on Assistance to Ukrainian Civilians

The university informs the applicant that previous education must be confirmed via AIC procedure

AIC interviews the applicant **in person**

AIC issues a statement that:

1. The applicant's educational documents are registered in Ukrainian diploma registry, or their existence is confirmed by Ukrainian ENIC
2. Confirms the path of the applicant's previous education
3. The applicant has studied at an existing education institution and existing educational programme
4. Evidence of the applicant's previous education has not been obtained

The costs (72 EUR) are covered by the state
