

# Pathways to Enhanced Assessment and Recognition for those achieving Learning within and beyond national borders (PEARL)

Building on past successes, the Erasmus+ National Agency in the UK is hosting an Erasmus+ Transnational Cooperation Activity taking the form of a **Peer Learning Event** which will be held over 2 days (4-5 July 2017) in Birmingham, UK. A draft programme of activities is enclosed.

In this event, high-level practitioners and experts, from across Europe, are invited to discuss how European transparency and recognition tools - specifically those aimed at facilitating assessment and recognition in VET and mobility - for example: ECVET, EQAVET and Europass - can be best employed in the future, taking into account recent European policy developments, national perspectives, operational successes and potential barriers to the continuing and wider use of all such tools and instruments.

As a result of this event, a common accord and call for action will be delivered, with a view to facilitating continued development and improvement in VET mobility policies and practices, further informing the direction of future European developments or initiatives centred on learning recognition.

The working language of this peer learning event will be English.
