About Nordplus

Nordplus is a mobility and network programme for education in the Nordic and Baltic countries, including the autonomous regions of Åland, the Faroe Islands and Greenland.

Nordplus is the largest educational programme within the Nordic Council of Ministers and funded by the Nordic and Baltic countries.

Annual budget of approximately 9.7 million EUR

Target Groups

Nordplus is aimed at all educational sectors and organisations and institutions involved in learning and education. Only institutions or organisations can apply in Nordplus - you cannot apply as an individual.

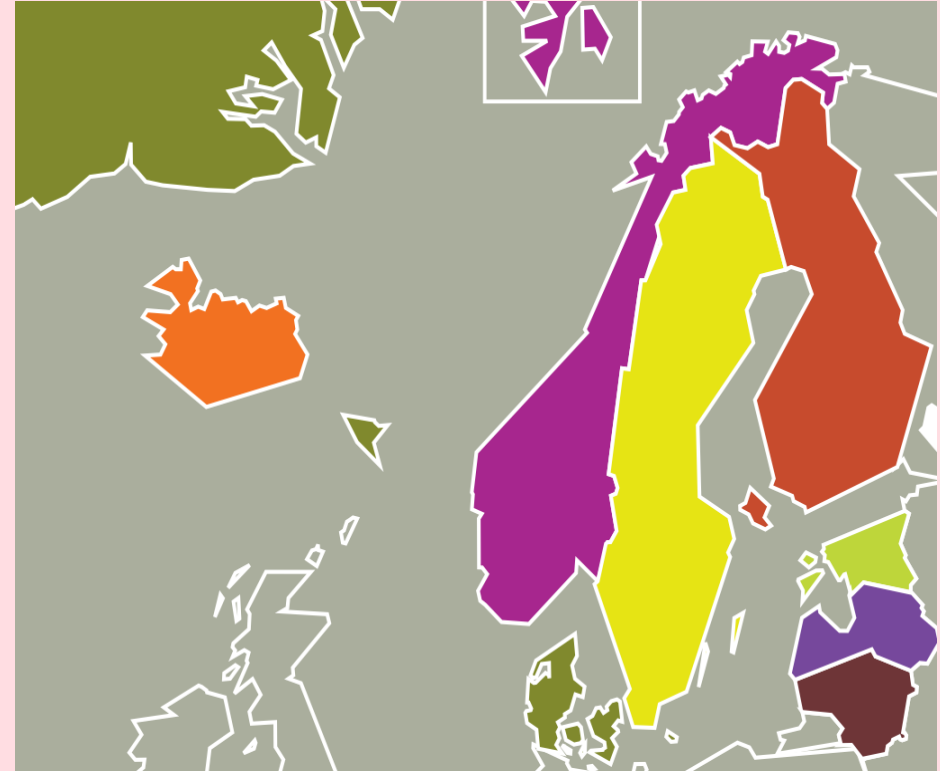
Nordplus sub-programmes

Nordplus consists of 5 sub-programmes that cover all educational levels:

- **Nordplus Junior**
 - Preschools, primary schools, lower and upper secondary schools, vocational schools/apprentice programmes, culture schools
- **Nordplus Higher Education**
 - Higher education institutions with students studying for a bachelor's or master's degree
- **Nordplus Adult**
 - All kinds of organisations engaged in formal, non-formal and informal adult education
- **Nordplus Horizontal**
 - All kinds of organisations that want to work cross-sectorally with education
- **Nordplus Nordic Languages**
 - All kinds of organisations that want to work with educational aspects of Nordic languages, including Nordic minority languages

Nordplus programme countries

- **The 5 Nordic countries**
Iceland, Finland, Denmark, Sweden and Norway
- **The 3 autonomous regions**
Åland, the Faroe Islands, Greenland
– as individual countries
- **The 3 Baltic countries**
Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania



What should the project be about?

More about the Nordplus highlight 2023 and 2024: **Social sustainability**

- The focus point of social sustainability is people, and the term aims at securing inclusion, equality, non-discrimination, welfare, good health and opportunities for all people regardless of gender, ethnicity, sexual orientation, religion, disability, age etc.
- Social sustainability increases social cohesion, which, among other things, involves strong civil societies, active participation in democracy, critical thinking, freedom of speech and a strong voice for children and youth. Social sustainability is the opposite of polarization.
- The highlight can be reflected in the choice of topic (e.g. inclusion, integration of immigrants etc.) or in the implementation of the project (e.g. selection of target group, participants etc.)

NB! The project does not have to be related to the highlight in order to receive funding

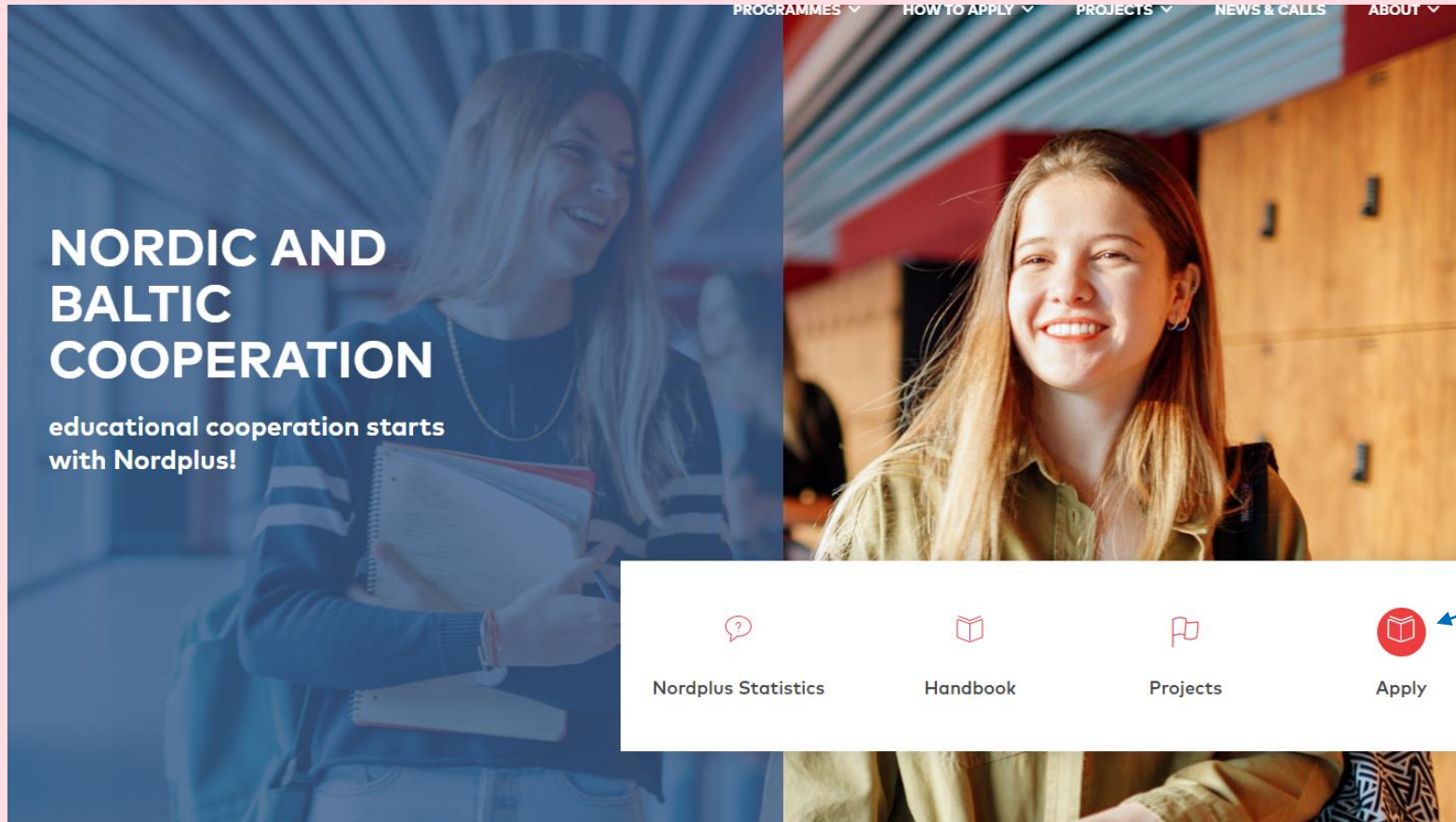


How do you apply to Nordplus?

- Applications must be submitted electronically through the system Espresso
- You find Espresso on our website www.nordplusonline.org – click the button “Apply”

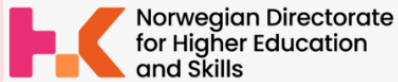
