"Individual Fellowships" (IF) is the Horizon 2020 Marie Skłodowska-Curie Action (MSCA) that funds excellent researchers who look to boost their career prospects through scientific and soft skills development as well as cross-sectoral experiences. MSCA-IF funds the **best**, **most promising individual researchers**, from anywhere in the world, who **must comply with the** 

following Criteria at the time of the Call Deadline (14 September 2017):

- **Experience**: candidate researchers must be in possession of a Doctoral degree, or have at least four years of full-time-equivalent experience in research;
- **Mobility**: in most cases (few exceptions), candidate researchers must not have resided and/or carried out their main activity in the country of the target-Host-Institution for more than twelve months in the past three years.

The **State Education Development Agency** strongly encourages and supports the submission of MSCA-IF proposals. In order to promote participation and to properly prepare for potential submissions, SEDA organizes a two-day "Mini-Boot-Camp Workshop", on 8 - 9 June 2017, which will be delivered by **Mr. Pierantonios Papazoglou**; COO of ECOCYPRIA Ltd and former MSCA National Contact Point and Programme Committee Member for Cyprus.

The Workshop is ideal for prospective Applicants, Academic staff potentially acting as Supervisors, as well as international-relations/ HR/ research-support administrative staff.
