The Polish National Agency for the Erasmus+ Programme, together with the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA), is organizing a training session on preparing applications for Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees (EMJMDs) under the 2018 Erasmus+ Call for Proposals in order to help potential Beneficiaries to better understand the idea of the Joint Masters and the award criteria applied to the action as well as to get familiar with the instructions on completing the application form.

EMJMDs action is managed centrally by the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency in Brussels. Agency's representatives who will participate in the event are specializing in EMJMDs projects, have a sound knowledge and day-to-day experience in managing this action.
